2) The Club reserves the right to refuse admission or eject from the ground any person who refuses to be searched by any servant or agent of the club or any Police Officer.

3) No glass bottles, drinking glasses or other such article or object is permitted in the ground and the Club Officals / Stewards will have the right to seize or confiscate any item or article considered to be a danger to others.

4) Climbing of the fences, stands and other structures including sitting on the barriers around the pitch is not permitted.

Coggeshall Town v Stanway Pegasus Pre Season Friendly, 20th July 2024.

It was Coggeshall who got this tenant v landlords match underway, but it did not take long for Pegasus to take the lead.

A long ball found ex Seedgrower, Max Booth, who rounded keeper, Ben Jones, with only five minutes gone. Pegasus continued to attack, and defender Joe Borein had to make a crucial tackle to defy them, but they did have two corners, which came to nothing.

Spencer Claydon did have a shot from distance for Coggeshall, which did not trouble Sam Felgate in the Pegasus goal.

Coggeshall came more into the match, as Felgate had to leave his penalty area to clear from Lewis Wallman, followed by efforts from Jimmy Sefia, Adam Hewitt, James Long and a shot from Jack Charnock from the halfway line that was just wide of the target. A cross from Wallman looked like it only needed a touch from Todd Hollocks and this was followed by a shot that Felgate could only parry but Jimmy Makanjuola put his shot wide.

Makanjuola and Hewitt had efforts saved before Pegasus finished the half-stronger with a corner that was headed across the goal without anyone getting a touch.

Coggeshall pushed forward from the restart, but the match soon became end to end, Booth winning a corner for Pegasus and Aaron Dyson's cross evading everyone for Coggeshall. Coggeshall's substitute keeper suffered a leg injury and was replaced by Jones.

On the hour, another ex-Coggeshall player, Harry Pinkney, hit a stinging shot that Jones could only parry and Booth scored from the rebound.

Pinkney hit a shot narrowly wide, and Jones had to save a long shot then, Sefia and Makanjuola failed in their efforts.

Todd Hollocks hit a screamer from just outside the penalty area that gave Felgate no chance to make it 2-1 with 68 minutes gone. Wallman tried to set up Todd Hollocks but his shot was blocked and both Sefia and Charnock put shots over the bar. Jones diverted a shot from Harvey Evans for a corner.

From another Pegasus corner, Coggeshall broke away, but Felgate parried Sefia's shot to safety. In stoppage time, a cross from Borein was dropped by Felgate and put into the net by Sam Hollocks, but the referee blew for a foul on the keeper.

A Pegasus corner hit the top of the crossbar and the referee blew for time.

Haverhill Borough Football Club is a football club based in Haverhill in England. They are currently members of the Eastern Counties League Division One North and play at the New Croft also home to Haverhill Rovers.

History

The club was established in 2011 as Haverhill Sports Association.

The new club joined Division One of the Essex & Suffolk Border Football League and won it at the first attempt, and were promoted to the Premier Division.

The following season the club entered the FA Vase for the first time, knocking out three clubs from higher divisions, before losing in the third round.

They finished second in the Premier Division, earning promotion to Division One of the Eastern Counties League.

In the summer of 2013 the club adopted its current name.

In the 2013–14 season the club narrowly missed out on promotion, finishing fourth in Division One.

In 2015–16 they won the Division One Knock-Out Cup.

The following season saw the club finish third in Division One, earning promotion to the Premier Division.

Their first season in the Premier Division ended in relegation to Division One North. At the end of the 2020–21 season they were transferred to Division

Haverhill Borough appointed Haverhill Rovers Under-18 boss Harry Zachariou as first-team manager in wake of Rhys Shulver's departure from The New Croft.

The former Cambridge United academy coach was installed as Borough boss in April 2023 and his side finished second from bottom in the Thurlow Nunn League First Division North last campaign.

However, no teams were relegated from the league, with bottom-of-the-table Needham Market Under-23s surviving one a points-per-game basis and Borough receiving an automatic reprieve from the drop.

Shulver has departed the club because of work commitments – that he is juggling alongside a masters degree.

Facilities and football development manager at The New Croft, Peter Betts, stated he 'certainly was not sacked'. "Rhys obviously did a really good job last year, keeping

things afloat and giving young players opportunities, which is obviously the remit, in reality, for Haverhill Borough," said Betts.

"Conversations have been ongoing because he always puts the football club before others. He voiced bits across the season in terms of the work commitments that he had.

"He's made that decision. Most coaches that look after their workload probably would have just walked away in February and left the football club to deal with the aftermath.

"But he committed his time and efforts until the final game of the season and made sure that the club stayed in the league. From a club perspective, we can't thank Rhys enough for what he's done.

"The committee had a discussion around the direction of the football club, Rhys has got loads on in terms of his work commitments and other things he devotes in terms of his own personal time to football."

We were Champions again in 2011/12 and won the PFA Senior cup at Peterborough United's Ground to complete the Double. This was lan Dunn's first spell at the club.

2015 (2016)- Dunn was to re-join the club in the 2015/16 season with Allan Ross and together they forged a formidable team.

After a poor start to the league campaign, we went on a great run to finish 3rd that term and won the Presidents Shield.

2016 (2017) - We retained the Presidents Shield in the 2016/17 season, and we gave ourselves a nickname. "The Knights" were born and we went on to gain promotion to the United Counties League.

The nickname was born from the home of Pinchbeck United in Knight Street, however with

the field not registering any wins in the disrupted and ultimately expunged seasons due to Coronavirus. 2021 – Under new management with Lewis Thorogood and his backroom staff as well as a new look squad the club is once again excited to see what the future brings in step 5 football.

2021-2022 – After rebuilding the squad and having a very young side, the team managed to get a reprieve from relegation on PPG basis finishing 17th out of 18 teams and taking it down to the last game of the season.

2022-2023 – After five years of trying Pinchbeck United won their first ever respective FA competition matches in the extra preliminary round of FA Cup against Melton Town after a replay before losing to Shepshed Dynamo of step 4 in the preliminary round.

The club also reached the Fourth Round proper of the FA Vase after starting from the first qualifying round beating Holbeach Utd, Deeping Rangers, Sherwood Colliery, Dunkirk & St Panteleimon before falling to an away defeat in the last 32 to Congleton Town.

2023-2024 – After six seasons at step 5, and maintaining the clubs ethos of working with young footballers unfortunately the club were relegated to step 6 on goal difference. They will now play in the Eastern Counties Division One North for the 24/25 season

Stanway Pegasus Football Club was derived from the most successful Sunday League side in Colchester history, AFC Pegasus, who won an incredible 64 honours over a period of 30 years with Paul and Heather Booth at the helm for every one of them.

AFC Pegasus in turn was created from Pegasus Youth in 1985 who had a great history in the Colchester Youth League for many years dating back to the early 1970's with the founder being Mr Peter Peters.

When Paul and Heather stepped aside a new era was about to begin and the transition from Sunday League to Saturday football for the senior team in 2018 opened the door for the return of the youth set up at the club.

With passion and drive to succeed than ever before, both off and off the pitch, we were ready to start that new era. With various youth and men's teams in full swing, our vision is to be one of the biggest clubs in Essex that has men's teams competing at a high level of non-league football who lead the way for the youth set-up. This youth set-up will progress through their age groups starting at U6's, all the way through to U18's.

This is what we call 'The Pathway'. Although player development is a key aspect of our philosophy, the aim for the youth is to enjoy playing football for Stanway Pegasus and looking at the talented home grown youth squads we have, boys and girls the future is looking very good under the guidance of our Head of Youth Ray Turner (Pictured).

The Club prides itself hugely on former and current players plus youth managers taking



up major roles within the Club whilst surrounding ourselves with people we trust.

Soon to be added to the Pegasus family were the women, girls and recently the Vets as the club proudly sits at over 30 teams have been the fastest growing Club in the area and success Is no stranger with many league titles and promotions along with cup success the Club Is blossoming into a huge success story and long may It continue.

Senior football for the men's first team was secured for the first time at the end of the 2021 /22 season with the team gaining promotion from Essex and Suffolk Border Premier League where they went unbeaten winning the league with 98 points from 34 games scoring 126 goals in the process.

They also beat Tiptree Heath 1-0 in the League Cup Final at Little Oakley. Max Booth was the Division's top goal scorer with 34 (26 league and 8 Cup)

2022/23 Season saw the team in the Eastern Counties Division One South where we narrowly lost out on promotion at the first attempt via a penalty

shoot out after a 2-2 draw against Sporting Bengal.

Although heartbreaking at the time looking back and what a debut season for the club in senior football. Callum Griffith was the Division's top goal scorer with 32 (29 league and 3 Cup / Play offs)

Rosi Webb has been a revelation for our club during this period being the Men's 1st team manager while also playing in the successful ladies' teams she is Mrs Pego and quite rightly getting the accolades she deserves.

From the 2023/24 Season the Men's first team moved sideways from the Eastern Counties Division One South division to the North division while the Men's Reserve team are competing in the Essex and Suffolk Border League's Premier Division.

The ladies have been just as successful in a short period of time with winning the Essex County Woman's Premier League piping by 2 points local rivals Stanway Rovers to seal back to back promotions that now see them competing in the Eastern Region League for the first time as the club looks to push on in all fronts.

A Ladies reserve team was started up and joined the Essex County Woman's League Division 3.

The club also entered the FA Vase for the first time playing six matches beating Haverhill Borough, Takeley, Halstead Town, Barkingside and London Lions before falling to Romford in the 4th Round proper.

The first team season end in Play Off defeat for a second season running, this time 3-0 at Holland FC in the Semi Finals.
