GROUND REGULATIONS

All persons entering the Stadium on match days are only admitted subject to these rules and regulations:

- 1) The Club reserves the right to eject from the ground and prosecute, if thought appropriate, any person within the clubs premises who is considered in breach of the following: **a)** Entering the ground by any means other than through the proper turnstiles or gates. **b)** Entering the field of play before, during or after the game. **c)** Using obscene or abusive language or persistent swearing likely to cause offence. **d)** Using terms of abuse, racial or otherwise, that is likely to offend. **e)** Being drunk or being under the influence of drugs. **f)** Making vulgar or obscene gestures. **g)** Carrying any offensive object or throwing any article onto the field of play.
- 2) The Club reserves the right to refuse admission or eject from the ground any person who refuses to be searched by any servant or agent of the club or any Police Officer.
- 3) No glass bottles, drinking glasses or other such article or object is permitted in the ground and the Club Officials / Stewards will have the right to seize or confiscate any item or article considered to be a danger to others.
- 4) Climbing of the fences, stands and other structures including sitting on the barriers around the pitch is not permitted.
- 5) All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.
- 6) Only players, officials and club personnel may enter the changing room area.

Firstly we would like to welcome the management team, players, committee and supporters of Diss Town Football Club to Coggleshall Town. We hope you have all had good trips here and all have a safe journey home.

Diss Town, we have played each other 3 times to now, last season Diss Town won both fixtures 1-0 and the first game this season Diss Town again won 1-0. Time to break that run today hopefully.

Last time we were here it was a hard fought 3-1 win over Wivenhoe Town then on our travels we lost 3-2 at Saffron Walden Town in the Essex Senior Cup. Twice they knocked us out 3-2 two weeks running.

Then a couple of road trips to Swaffham Town winning 4-0 with all the goals in the second half and last Saturday a 3-2 win up at FC Parson Drove.

On Tuesday we had a local trip to Holland FC, it was a very poor first half, the grass was long and hardly any football was played on the floor and the game was constantly stopping for fouls and injuries.

In the second half it improved slightly but not much. We took the lead but Holland quickly levelled with a harsh penalty. The referee then evened things up and gave us a penalty as sent off a Holland player for a second yellow. A third sealed the points in a game we played poorly but won.

Massive week coming up. The draw for the FA Vase was made and for the second year running we got a trip to London Lions from near Barnet, having won against them on penalties last season. They are a step above and will be up for revenge so we expect a very tough game.

Before that the small matter of the League Cup. On Tuesday evening shall expect fireworks when we travel to League Cup holders and Division One South title favourites Harlow Town. Harlow have a nice stadium and a new 4g pitch so it should be a good game. The Draw for the last 16 has been made and the winners will be at home v Holland Fc or Dunmow Town around mid December.

1886



TO 2024

Diss Town was formed in 1886 after a suggestion from the local cricket club who shared their ground at Roydon Road. The Club played friendly matches at first but in 1891/2 won their first trophy when they defeated Yarmouth 2nd XI in the Norfolk Junior Cup Final. The Club's first league football came in 1906/7 when they joined the Norwich and District League.

They reached the final of the Norfolk Junior Cup again in 1924/5 but this time lost to Jewson Athletic. During this period Diss were to meet Ipswich Town (then a Southern Amateur side) on three occasions in the FA Amateur Cup. Diss lost 4-2 in 1929/30 and by the same score in a replay two seasons later (following a 3-3 draw).

In 1935/6 Diss were elected to the Norfolk and Suffolk League and in 1950/1 entered the FA Cup for the first time. In 1955/6 they were runners up in the league and beaten finalists in the League Cup competition. They did however win the League

Cup in 1956/7, 1959/60 (shared with Gothic) and 1960/1.

The Club joined the newly formed Anglian Combination in 1964/5 and in 1967/8 won the Division One championship and the League Cup. The Division One championship was won again in 1973/4 and in 1974/5 they won the Norfolk Senior Cup for the first time defeating St Andrews 3-2 at Carrow Road. During the same season they were runners up in the Anglian Combination Premier Division.

In 1975/6 they again had to settle for the runners up spot but there was consolation in winning the League Cup. In 1976/7 the Club finally won the League Championship, a feat they repeated in 1978/9. There were also further League Cup victories

in 1979/80 and 1981/2.

In 1983/4 the club moved from Roydon Road to a newly acquired six acre site at Brewers Green Lane. A new clubhouse and AstroTurf all weather playing area were soon added. In 1988/9 Diss left the Anglian Combination to join the newly formed 1st Division of the Jewson Eastern League. After a couple of near misses they finally won the Division One championship in 1991/2. The same season saw the club reach the quarter finals of the FA Vase (bowing out by the only goal in a replay against eventual winners Wimborne Town) and the final of the Norfolk Senior Cup.

Again a replay was their undoing, losing 2-1 to Fakenham Town following a 2-2 draw. There was cup success for the Reserves however when they won the Norfolk Junior Cup (Exactly 100 years after the first team had won it in 1892). They were unable to defend the cup due to promotion to Senior football.



Off the field of play further developments were being added. A new covered stand with seating for 270 was also completed in 1992, a covered standing area behind one goal in 1998 and further clubhouse extensions in 2004.

The 1993/4 season was the greatest in the clubs history. The FA Vase 'run' which started in November against Tring Town climaxed on May 7th 1994 with a visit to Wembley Stadium to play Taunton Town in the final. Diss had also defeated Ford United, Torpoint Athletic, Kings Lynn, Tiverton Town and Atherton Laburnum Rovers to earn their place at the "home of football".

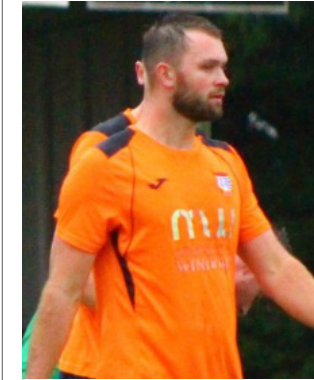
Before a crowd of 13,450 Diss trailed for much of the game but a penalty from Paul Gibbs

deep into injury time and an extra time winner from Peter Mendham brought them victory and signaled a celebration in Diss the likes of which had never been seen before.

In 1995/6 Diss were runners up in the Jewson League but won the Norfolk Senior Cup for the 2nd time beating Wroxham 4-0 in the final. The next season however the Yachtsmen gained revenge with a 4-1 victory at Carrow Road.



In the 2000/01 season the team reached the Jewson League final for the first time in its history but were beaten 3-1 by Wroxham. Diss played in three successive Norfolk Senior Cup Finals under Robert Fleck.

They beat Yarmouth 4-1 in 2003 and Wroxham 3-0 in 2005 but were beaten on penalties by Wroxham in 2004.

Diss were relegated to Division One in 2007 and beat Hadleigh 1-0 in The Division One Cup Final in the 2008/09 season under the management of Rob Taylor. Promotion back to the Premier Division was secured at the end of the 2010/11 season. A new 3G surface was installed to upgrade facilities in September 2011.

At the start of the 2009/10 season Diss included a full range of Youth Teams after Bressingham Youth approached The Tangerines with a view to a merger.

This was approved by The Members of both Clubs. Young players start the route to the Diss First Team from the age of seven wearing the tangerine shirt. This included the addition of a girls team for the first time in 2011/12. They were relegated back to Division One at the end of the 2015-15 Season.

Ross Potter and Dominic Jones but in May 2017 left for Wroxham. The Club then had a succession of Managers Jason Cook and then for 2019, Jon Abbott and Lewis Plowman Who left in 2020.

They were replaced by Michael King then Covid hit and caused disruption in the fixtures with Michael leaving and Matt Cootie and Mark Sutcliffe taking over leaving us at the end of the 2022/23 season.

During the closed season we were approached by Declan Rudd and the FFE to form a partnership for the forthcoming season this lead to the appointment of Garth Good and Dan Goffin as Managers for the 2023/2024 Season

Stanway Pegasus Football Club was derived from the most successful Sunday League side in Colchester history, AFC Pegasus, who won an incredible 64 honours over a period of 30 years with Paul and Heather Booth at the helm for every one of them.

AFC Pegasus in turn was created from Pegasus Youth in 1985 who had a great history in the Colchester Youth League for many years dating back to the early 1970's with the founder being Mr Peter Peters.

When Paul and Heather stepped aside a new era was about to begin and the transition from Sunday League to Saturday football for the senior team in 2018 opened the door for the return of the youth set up at the club.

With passion and drive to succeed than ever before, both off and off the pitch, we were ready to start that new era. With various youth and men's teams in full swing, our vision is to be one of the biggest clubs in Essex that has men's teams competing at a high level of non-league football who lead the way for the youth set-up. This youth set-up will progress through their age groups starting at U6's, all the way through to U18's.

This is what we call 'The Pathway'. Although player development is a key aspect of our philosophy, the aim for the youth is to enjoy playing football for Stanway Pegasus and looking at the talented home grown youth squads we have, boys and girls the future is looking very good under the guidance of our Head of Youth Ray Turner.

The Club prides itself hugely on former and current players plus youth managers taking



up major roles within the Club whilst surrounding ourselves with people we trust.

Soon to be added to the Pegasus family were the women, girls and recently the Vets as the club proudly sits at over 30 teams have been the fastest growing Club in the area and success is no stranger with many league titles and promotions along with cup success the Club is blossoming into a huge success story and long may it continue.

Senior football for the men's first team was secured for the first time at the end of the 2021 /22 season with the team gaining promotion from Essex and Suffolk Border Premier League where they went unbeaten winning the league with 98 points from 34 games scoring 126 goals in the process.

They also beat Tiptree Heath 1-0 in the League Cup Final at Little Oakley. Max Booth was the Division's top goal scorer with 34 (26 league and 8 Cup)

2022/23 Season saw the team in the Eastern Counties Division One South where we narrowly lost out on promotion at the first attempt via a penalty

shoot out after a 2-2 draw against Sporting Bengal.

Although heartbreaking at the time looking back and what a debut season for the club in senior football. Callum Griffith was the Division's top goal scorer with 32 (29 league and 3 Cup / Play offs)

Rosi Webb (Pictured) has been a revelation for our club during this period being the Men's 1st team manager while also playing in the successful ladies' teams she is Mrs Pego and quite rightly getting the accolades she deserves.
